She is an invited professor of Osaka University, Guest Professor of Tokyo University of Agriculture and Technology and others.

She got 23 prizes: the Commendation for Science and Technology by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, Award of the Minister of Internal Affairs and Communications, the Achievement Award, the Society Activity Contribution Award, the Best Author award from the Information Processing Society of Japan, a prize of National Commendation for Invention, and so on. She authored and co-authored 13 books, over 300 patents, over 300 technical papers on multimedia information system, human interface design, and so on.
