 - (1) Overseas recruitment planning/implementation (① outreach to top schools in priority countries/regions, ② outreach via international accreditation educational institutions, ③ coordination/activities with overseas agents/liaisons)
 - (2) Overseas recruitment strategy proposals and survey research related to operational improvements
 - (3) Coordination with various Gateway College departments
6. Qualifications
 - (1) Academic: The candidate should possess a master's degree or higher, or equivalent/greater abilities/practical experience. The candidate should have advanced English communication proficiency.
 - (2) Professional: Candidates must have work experience at domestic or overseas universities in overseas recruiting, overseas PR activities, international student admissions etc.
 - (3) Other: Candidates should be motivated to actively promote student recruitment domestically and abroad and research/implementation related to PR activities (including coordination with TU departments, and external higher education institutions domestically and abroad). Candidates with knowledge/skills related to data analysis and ICT system administration/operation are preferred. Those with Japanese skills sufficient for everyday conversation preferred.
