Japan has suspended the use of 1.63 million doses of Moderna's COVID-19 vaccine, after the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare received reports of contaminants in some vials.

The Vaccination Center in downtown Sendai jointly run by Tohoku University and the local government, has confirmed that while it did receive vaccine doses from the lot, none of it has been used.

The center remains open and safe, and all local residents with appointments will be able to get their vaccinations as planned.

This reassurance comes as the national government puts Miyagi in a full state of emergency until September 12, due to rising numbers of COVID-19 infections.

### **Vaccination coupons (Updated September 21) New!**

All vaccination coupons must be returned to the government. So:

- If you have received your vaccination coupons, please submit them to the office of your department as soon as possible.
- If you have received your coupons and have an upcoming appointment to be vaccinated, please bring your coupons to the vaccination center and submit them there.
- If you have not received your coupons, please check that your official registered address is where you are currently living. If it's not, please have someone at the registered address forward your coupons to you when they arrive. You should then submit the coupons to the office of your department as soon as possible.

**In all cases, please make sure to write Tohoku University and the name of your department at the top right corner on the back side of the coupons.**
